

Alma Foundation Special Meeting, July 12th 2007

Meeting called to order at 5:33 p.m.

• **Camping:** Wristbands have arrived. The fee will be \$15 per person over the age of 17. A community fire was suggested. Bonnie offered to see about borrowing a burn pit.

• **Vendors:** There are 10 food vendors, 3 of who might not be properly licensed. 34 artist spaces have been filled, 15 are still available.

Each vendor will be given a \$5 coupon redeemable at the front tent.

Pre-registration will be offered at this year's rate (\$80).

The vendors will be surveyed to try to improve the festival from their point of view.

Nancy suggested an opinion booth.

• **Apparel:** Prices were set as follows: Long sleeve, \$20. Short sleeve, \$15. Crew neck sweatshirt, \$25. Pullover hooded sweatshirt, \$30. Zippered hooded sweatshirt, \$40.

• **Miscellaneous:** There was a discussion regarding division of labor. All volunteers will float as needed.

Obie and Sue will be in charge of cup washing.

Nancy said that some fireworks were left over to set off after the music ended on Saturday (estimated at 10 p.m.)

Caroline suggested a mining corner with non-precious stones hidden in sand.

One prisoner on work release will be available.

Cara will distribute anti-tobacco material.

The Northwest Fire Protection District will have a breakfast on Sunday.

Obie will handle signs, plumbing, and some electrical.

Nancy and Caroline arranged a shopping trip for needed supplies.

Alcohol prices were set as follows: Beer, \$3. Bloody Mary, \$6. 22 oz. Bloody Mary, \$8.

CDOT will not work during the festival weekend.

Ellen will have a bucket out to fund putting the old Alma newspaper on the internet. The library, archives, and PCHPAC will be asked to make up the difference.
